EVENT HISTORY

EVENT STATUS

- Engraved Perpetual Trophy Event
- Jean Derrin event with Senior Order of Merit (SOOM) in conjunction

FORMAT

- 36 hole individual stroke play over two consecutive days (Scratch) Seeded draw Day
 1 and Performance based draw Day
- Associates Red Course (Red tees)
- The event shall be played in accordance with the Club's By-Laws, the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, the Local Rules on the back of the Scorecard and any supplementary Temporary Local Rules that may be applicable on the date of play.

ELIGIBILITY

Gender: FemaleAge: Unrestricted

Handicaps: Open to players with GA Handicap Limit of 12.0 at the time of entry

 A player with a Provisional, Suspended, Lapsed, Frozen or Unallocated GA Handicap is not eligible to enter the event.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Entries open Thursday, 7 March 2024 via MiTournament
- Entry Fee: \$170.00 (Australian Golf Club Members \$100.00) (includes light lunch both days).
- Field size: 84 players
 - o In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the field, a ballot will take place.
 - o Players with the highest handicap (at the time of close of entries) will progressively be removed and placed on the reserve list.
 - Entrants who are balloted out and do not make the final field will be refunded in full after the event has concluded.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS (Cont'd)

- An entrant who withdraws after the close of entries (Thursday, 4 April 2024) will not be refunded.
 - o Cancellations on the day please phone 02) 9663 2515
 - Late entries will only be accepted with Match Committee approval
- Any player who enters on a correct GA handicap within the prescribed limits at close of entries (subject to field limit) and whose handicap increases beyond the specified limit will be eligible to compete, however must play off the maximum handicap allowed for this event.

TROPHY & PRIZES

Prizes awarded to

0	Best 36 hole scratch aggregate (Trophy Winner)	\$300
0	2 nd place scratch aggregate	\$150
0	3 rd place scratch aggregate	\$75
0	Best net score	\$120

• A player can only win one prize. 1st place takes precedence over 2nd place

0	Day 1 Scratch Winner	\$70
0	Day 1 Net Winner	\$50
0	Day 2 Scratch Winner	\$70
0	Day 2 Net Winner	\$50

TIES

- In the event of a tie in the 36 hole Scratch Joint winners will be declared
- In the event of a tie in the 36 hole Net, the result will be determined by count-back using net scores over holes 19-36, 28-36, then 31-36, then 34-36, then hole-by-hole working back from hole 36.
- In the event of a tie in the 18 holes Scratch and Net events the result will be determined by count-back using gross and net scores (respectively) over holes 10-18, then 13-18, then 16-18, then hole-by-hole working back from hole 18.

MOTORISED TRANSPORT

 Use of a motorised cart is permitted in this event for players who are medically unfit to walk 18-holes. A medical certificate must be supplied to the Match Committee via fduncan@australiangolfclub.com

OTHER CONDITIONS

- The Match Committee reserves the right to amend the terms at any time including the right to arrange and/or alter starting times. The decision of the Match Committee is final in all matters.
- A player's scorecard is considered returned when the player has placed it in a designated scorecard box or submitted it to a Golf Shop staff member and subsequently exited the Golf Shop.
- The result of the competition is final once all scores have been sent to GOLF Link
- Caddies are permitted
- The Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited shall apply, together with Local Rules and Temporary Local Rules supplied by the Match Committee.
- Mobile Phones: All mobile phones and other electronic devices must be on silent at all times if carried in the Clubhouse or on the golf course. Making and receiving phone calls is only permitted in the car park.
